

# Use the pivot gadget



Pivot Gadget is in Basic Maintenance mode.

From the toolbar, you can drag & drop dimensions on any of the pivot areas:

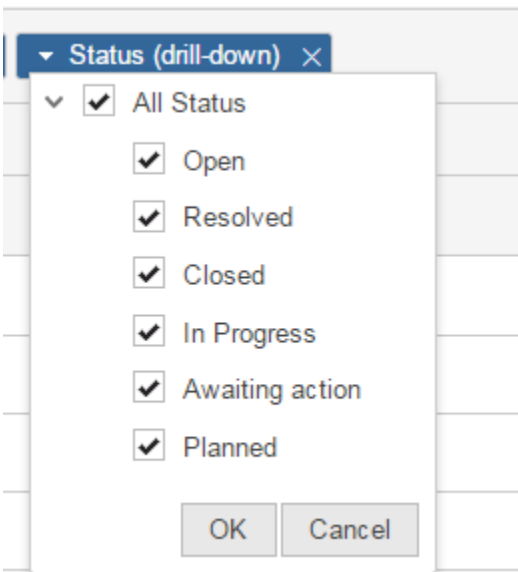
- Filter
- Columns
- Rows

The combination of filter, column and row dimension drives the calculation of the selected aggregation.

Aggregations can be dragged into the **Measures** box.

## Limiting the number of entries on a dimension.

By clicking on the small '>' on the left side of the dimension, a drop-down will show listing all individual values of the dimension. Toggle each of the checkboxes to select all relevant values. Press OK to confirm your selection.



## Export to Excel

Export raw statistics data and Pivot with selected dimensions and aggregations to Excel.
